A LIFE OF WORSHIP

'There came unto him a woman havina an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on his head, as he sat at meat"- Matthew 26:7.

It is my pleasure and privilege to welcome you to the month of May, 2017, the women's month. A time to celebrate womanhood and motherhood and the Grace of

God upon their lives. Theme: "A Life of Worship"

All of creations were created to worship the God that created them (Rev. 4:11). Worship of our creator is doing His Will in total obedience, even when it is difficult.
